The participation fee of 990 PLN (Polish participants) or 200 EUR (non-Polish participants) is payable by 30 December 2018 (early registration), 15 March 2019 (late registration) by means of bank transfer. There is one conference fee for all conference tracks (submissions of short papers for Proceedings and long papers for journals). Accommodation, transportation to Toruń and any other costs are excluded from the participation fee. After that date, participation is possible at a walk-in participation fee, payable in cash on site during conference registration.
