we are pleased to invite you to the 13th *International Conference on Applied Economics: Contemporary Issues in Economy* (June 26–27, 2025; Olsztyn, Poland), which is hosted by Institute of Economic Research (Poland), Polish Economic Society Branch in Toruń, University of Warmia and Mazury in Olsztyn and Gdańsk University of Technology. The event takes place in cooperation with leading scientific institutions in Central Europe. The conference is especially addressed to economists from all European Union countries and Eastern Europe. Papers in economics, finance, and business management are highly encouraged.

Main conference fields include: macroeconomics, microeconomics, econometrics, international economics; financial markets, labour markets, institutions; business environment, management and marketing; and the most preferable Conference topics and special issues:

- the economics of artificial intelligence: business potentials and risks;
- digitalization and entrepreneurship in economics;
- transition in the energy market (improving energy efficiency, alternative energy sources, renewable energy, energy security);
- sustainable socio-economic development under global structural transformation.

MEET THE EDITORS SESSION AND PUBLICATIONS

During the conference the **Meet Editors Session** will be organized, where the participants will have the chance to talk directly to editors about the publication possibilities in the best scientific journals and the quality standards applied by Social Science Citation Index and Scopus journals.

All accepted conference papers (short articles) will be published in Conference Proceedings supplied with ISBN, ISSN and DOI number. The Conference Book supplied with ISBN and DOI number will include abstract of the papers accepted for the conference. All extended conference papers (long papers) will be reviewed for the publication in journals following their normal review criteria. The acceptance of a paper for the conference is not a guarantee of publication in the journals.

REGISTRATION AND CONFERENCE FEE

We ask participants to register for the conference:

- deadline for early online registration: 30 January 2025;
- deadline for late online registration: 20 March 2025.

In case of positive reviews and good cooperation with the authors, early registration participants who submit long papers for journals will have the opportunity to have their papers published before the conference in the journals *Oeconomia Copernicana* 2025, 16(1), 16(2) or *Equilibrium. Quarterly Journal of Economics and Economic Policy* 2025, 20(1), 20(2). However, due to the process of reviewing, the organizers do not guarantee the publication of all the accepted articles before the conference.

The participation fee of 1250 PLN (Polish participants) or 250 EUR (non-Polish participants) is payable by 20 February 2025 (early registration), 15 April 2025 (late registration) by means of bank transfer. There is one conference fee for all conference tracks (submissions of short papers for Proceedings and extended papers for journals). After that date, for non-Polish scientists, participation is possible at a walk-in participation fee, payable in cash on site during conference registration. All the conference events plus lunch and coffee-breaks on both conference days, as well as abstract publication in Conference Book of abstracts, and conference publication of short paper in Conference Book, are included in the participation fee. Accommodation, transportation to Olsztyn and any other costs are excluded from the participation fee.

The papers should be submitted by 10 March 2025 (early registration) or 30 April 2025 (late registration) electronically (MS Word) by e-mail titled "Conference" to: conference@contemporary-issues.pl.

The papers that do not meet the conference formatting criteria will not be included in the Conference Book, and will not be considered in the reviewing process for publications prepared after the conference.
